
ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS


- Please read carefully before start the assembly.
- A minimum 3 people required for assembly due to the legs needing to be aligned exactly with the top. Three people to hold the top, while the forth positions the legs accordingly. Also probably need to mention that utmost care is needed when placing the top onto the legs so that chipping doesn't occur.
- To prevent damage to your floor or carpet, please check the bottom of each piece of furniture for stain residue and roug
 h surfaces and check for staples or nails left after removing the packaging material.
 The manufacturer will not be held responsible if preventative steps are not taken prior to installation.
- Unpack and dispose of all packing material but be careful not to throw away any assembly parts or hardware.
 Read the instruction sheet and parts list carefully. Remove all staples and screws used for packaging carefully using pliers and (or) screwdrivers to prevent injury and scratching or damaging flooring.


A. SOLID MARBLE BASE [x3]

STEP 1:

Open legs (A) carefully. Place legs at final location with help of template. There are stickers (A/B/C) placed on all legs. So arrange the placement accordingly. Arrow () stickers are also placed the same area to show the correct orientation of bases. Marked face will go inside of the stone top (Image-1).

STEP 2:

Unpack the TABLETOP (B) carefully as it is heavy. There are stickers (A/B/C) placed on the top side of the stone top. Match the orientation of the stone top with legs and place it. If needed, adjust the placement of legs as per the cavity in the tabletop. 3 people are recommended for the assembly, 2 for holding top and 1 for leg alignment.




IMAGE 2-ASSEMBLY OF BASES WITH TOP

STEP 3:

The tabletop is locked to bases with gravity. Remove all stickers from stone top and bases. Your table is ready to use.




IMAGE 3-ASSEMBLED UNIT

CARE & MAINTANCE INSTRUCTIONS

- Use a clean soft cotton cloth to wipe the surface. Do not use abrasive or chemical cleaners.
- Wipe the surface immediately if any liquid product spills on the top.
- During normal use every day, screws, bolts, nuts, and wooden plugs may loosen up. They should
 be periodically inspected and re-tightened to prevent damage to the furniture and (or) personal property or
 cause injury. Always check to be sure all hardware on this list and the above-mentioned components is attached
 to the furniture properly and kept always tightened.
- In case of relocation, dismantle the product first and follow the assembly instructions for re-assembly.
